The City of Joliet has adopted a Responsible Bidder Ordinance (2-440). If the bidder is an individual, sole proprietorship, or partnership, this subsection shall not apply.
2. The bidder must have a valid Federal Tax Identification Number or Social Security Number (for individuals), documents evidencing current registration with the Illinois Department of Revenue and the Illinois Department of Employment Security (if bidder has employees).
3. The bidder must be an equal opportunity employer and comply with Section 2000(e) of Chapter 21, Title 42 of the United States Code and Executive Order 11246.
4. The bidder shall provide certificates of insurance indicating the following coverages if called for in the bid solicitation: general liability, workers compensation, completed operations, automobile, hazardous occupation, and product liability.

11. Disclosure of the name and address of each subcontractor from whom the contractor has accepted a bid and/or intends to hire on any part of the project. Further, each such subcontractor shall be required to adhere to the requirements set forth herein as though it were bidding directly to the city. Each contractor shall submit all subcontractor information and supporting documentation to the city prior to the subcontractor commencing work on the project.
12. Unless otherwise agreed to in a collective bargaining agreement, the bidder shall certify that it provides, or contributes to, a health care plan for those employees working on the project and shall provide a copy of the health care plan upon request. The contributions toward a health care plan must be part of the employee's regular compensation, and not merely part of the employee's compensation during the period of time for which the employee is performing work on the project.

13. Unless otherwise agreed to in a collective bargaining agreement, the bidder shall certify that it contributes to an employee pension or retirement program, including but not limited to a 401k, a defined benefit plan or a similar plan for its field employees working on the project and shall provide a copy of the plan upon request. Further, where the city deems necessary, the city may also require that the successful bidder remove the subcontractor from the project and replace it with a responsive and responsible subcontractor.

PURPOSE:

The intent of these specifications is to set forth minimum requirements for the purchase of a one (1) new and unused 2024 or 2025 single engine combination sewer and catch basin cleaner vacuum truck used for removing all debris commonly found in catch basins/ storm structures, sanitary sewer line / manholes using a front mounted operating station.

SCOPE:

This unit will be used for safely cleaning sewer lines and structures. The unit shall consist of a Positive Displacement (PD) Blower vacuum system, a hydraulically driven high pressure water pump, and enclosed sealed body for storage of collected debris and equipped with a self-contained water source supply as the source for the water pump system. The unit shall have the capability of operating both the vacuum and the water system simultaneously at full operating speeds continuously. The module is to be truck mounted on a new chassis as described in this specification. Use will be on local roadways, work sites, and landfills for operations and dumping of loads.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS
